Addendum B to the BLYC Regatta Sailing Instructions.

- 1. Identification: - Each boat shall conspicuously display the following pennants/flags from or near their backstays.**

An application to change sail numbers must be made in writing to the Race Office at RNIYC at least 24 hours before the event.

- 2. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions: - Notification of any amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be made by the Race Committee 30 minutes before the warning signal on Channel 37.**
- 3. Signals made ashore: - Signals to competitors will be made from the RUYC Battery.**

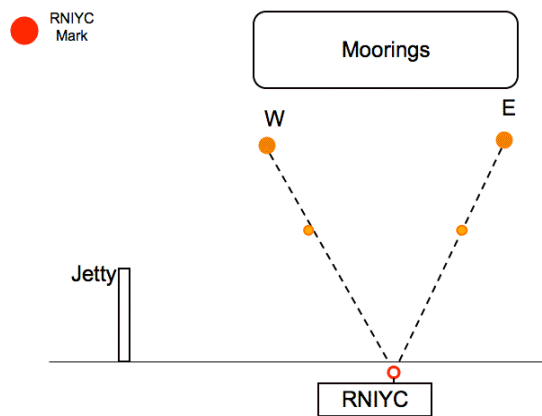
6. The starting line will be a line joining the pole with an X top mark in front of the battery and a red buoy marked SR if the start is from West to East or a green buoy marked SG if the start is from East to West.

7. Finish:

7.1 All courses finish in an easterly direction: all boats are required to sail between mark W and the RNIYC Battery, the finishing line is between mark E and a pole with an red circle on the RNIYC clubhouse. E & W are orange cylindrical marks. Inner limit marks are to be observed. (There is only about 2.5m of water at the inner limits at mid tide 14:40)

7.2 Shortened Course: If it becomes necessary to shorten the course being sailed the finish shall be between an orange & white pole on a committee vessel flying a blue flag and an appropriate mark of the course



8. Penalties: - Penalties in accordance with rules 44.1 & 44.2 shall apply.

9. Time Limit: - BLYC Sailing Instruction 9 is amended to read: - Time limit for the race is 16.00. If any boat finishes within the time limit there will be an extension of 30 minutes for boats in that class.

10. Safety: - It is recommended that life jackets be worn at all times.

11. Prizes: - The Knockdene Trophy will be awarded to the boat competing in the Madfish Challenge Round The Lough Race which has the best corrected time under the PY handicap. Other prizes will be awarded at the discretion of the organising club.
