## The Family Shipwreck Challenge Friday 11th August

The Shipwreck Challenge is a race with a difference!

1 Pico hull, No sails, No mast, No centre board and No rudder

Teams of 4, 2 of which must be cadets

The challenge is to navigate your hull around the course set on the day. How you choose to do this is up to you, although we do have some rules;

- The crew will consist of at least four people including two cades, two
  people must always remain on board. The Hull must have all four
  people on board when crossing the finish line.
  - 2. Crew members must not assist themselves, or receive assistance from the shore, or any other vessel, e.g., no towing.
  - Marine materials must not be used in propulsion or steering. Nor should the Hulls be modified.
  - 4. Paddles are not permitted, although versions of a paddle can be created.
- 5. No rowlocks or substitutes will be accepted. No form of rowing will be permitted.
  - No type of engine propulsion is allowed; however, Hulls can be paddled, pushed, swim-towed, or driven by human mechanical power.
- 7. Construction of equipment should be safe and use recycled products,e.g. no protruding nails, screws or sharp edges, etc.
  - 8. No physical interference between Hulls will be permitted offending crews may be disqualified.

- 9. Recognised lifejackets or approved buoyancy aids must be worn by all competitors - there will be no exception to this rule. The wearing of a helmet is strongly recommended
- 10. In all matters relating to the Race, the Committee's decision is final.
